## City Council Meeting Minutes

May 8, 2023
Mayor ProTem Hutchison called the meeting to order.
Members present: Scott Henson, Travis Berger, Eric Hughes and Matt Gideon.
Members absent: Mayor Prichard.
The agenda was approved by Henson seconded by Berger. On a roll call vote: Henson, Aye; Berger, Aye; Hughes, Aye; and Gideon, Aye. Mayor ProTem Hutchison declared the motion carried unanimously.
The consent agenda was presented, April 3, minutes, the April 2023 payables and receipts, the May 2023 payables and the March 2023 financials were presented. Maintenance Report: Zach said for March there was a $26 \%$ water loss. M. Gideon looked at the bill from Warren Water and calculated a price we were paying Warren Water which was fairly low, but we are still losing water throughout the city.
Fire Report: Chief Henson stated they were 17 EMS calls, 10 fire calls and 1 storm.

There was discussion on fees the city will have to pay to V\&K for the building at Hwy. 28. The city council asked the city clerk to contact the city attorney and get his recommendation and then contact Jason, the building inspector at V\&K.
