

City of Martensdale
Regular City Council Minutes
November 2, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The city council met in regular session at Martensdale City Hall, 380 Iowa Ave., Martensdale, IA at 7:00 p.m. on May 3, 2010. Mayor Scott Morrow called the meeting to order.

On a roll call vote the following members were present: Doug Reynolds, Scott Henson, Karen Bunch, and Ryan Baker.

Members absent: Danny Webster (military service).

The October 5, 2010 minutes and the consent agenda were approved on a motion by S. Henson, seconded by D. Reynolds. On a voice vote, Mayor Morrow declared the motion carried unanimously.

There was a copy of a golf cart ordinance from the City of Lacona. The Warren Co. Sheriff's Office had contacted Mayor Morrow and told him to get their copy. D. Reynolds said to table it to see if the city council wants to make any changes to the ordinance for the City of Martensdale.

McClure Engineering called and said they would attend the December meeting to discuss sewer updates for the City.

Mayor Morrow discussed the Citizen of the Year Award. He said the Groves family always decorates their house and the children look forward to going to their home.

Mayor Morrow told the city council that someone had contacted him regarding the sign posted on the Orefield's property. They were able to contact the bank about purchasing the home. The city clerk has contacted the lawn company to stop the mowing service.

Bob said the City of Indianola passed a resolution for storm water utility. He thought the maximum fee to residences was around \$400.00 to help pay for sewer costs. The city clerk will get a copy of their ordinance.
