

**City of Martensdale**  
**Regular Session Minutes**  
April 14, 2014

Meeting called to order by Mayor ProTem Wheeldon.

Members present: Scott Henson, Ryan Baker, John Carroll and Nathan Wheeldon.

Members absent: Mayor Morrow and Doug Reynolds.

The consent agenda and March 2014 minutes were approved on a motion by S. Henson; seconded by R. Baker. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor ProTem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously.

A wine permit for DanLee was presented and approved by S. Henson; seconded by R. Baker. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor ProTem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously.

There was discussion about the request to install a water line at Crows Park. The city attorney has said we need to see if the City has a contract with Warren Water first and then proceed with their request. The city clerk will contact Warren Water to see if the City has a current contract with them on water lines.

There was discussion about 415 Rock Island and the possibility of having the property condemned. The city clerk will contact Warren County to see who owns the property.

The 2015-16 budget was presented. R. Baker made a motion to accept the budget; seconded by J. Carroll. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor ProTem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously.

Randy Dake, 495 South St., Martensdale, IA was present to discuss the city council approving a firearm license for him to sell and do gun smithing out of his home. The ATF will make him post his hours, have locks on all gun cases and no inventory will be allowed in the home. He will have a secure room. His business will primarily be people ordering guns and picking them up from him. He wanted to know if the City would like him to do anything extra so he can open his business. He has sent an application to the ATF and Warren Co. Sheriff Office. Warren County has an open clause which means he has to have the City's approval.

N. Wheeldon said a storefront would be an ideal situation for him. S. Henson asked why he needed a secured room if he will have no inventory, Mr. Dake said he would store inventory until it is picked up in the secured room.

J. Carroll asked if the license was approved by the City, would residents be notified. Randy Dake said he has spoke with his current neighbors, but contacting all residents would be up to the city council. The city council asked the clerk to contact Warren County Sheriff's Office to get their opinion. This will be tabled until the May meeting.

J. Carroll made a motion to adjourn; seconded by R. Baker. Motion carried. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor ProTem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously.
