

**City of Martensdale**  
**Regular Session Minutes**

March 9, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Wheeldon.

Members present: S. Henson, R. Baker and J. Carroll.

Members absent: Mayor Morrow, D. Reynolds.

The consent agenda and minutes of Feb, 2, 2015 were presented. Henson made a motion to accept the minutes and consent agenda; seconded by Baker. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor Pro Tem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously.

The city clerk discussed her salary for the new budget with the city council and asked that the \$50.00 for her phone reimbursement not be included in her wages. J. Carroll made a motion to increase her salary by 5% instead of 4% as was passed in the February 2015 minutes plus \$50.00 per month towards her cell phone; seconded by S. Henson. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor Pro Tem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously.

There was discussion about the Lions Hall request to install handicap signs. The city attorney did not recommend letting the Lions Hall place their own handicap signs out. The attorney said anything to do with any handicap parking sign has to be done by the City with the property line drawing on the street and enforcement. The city council discussed having the Lions Hall placing their own No Parking signs during the lunches.

The city council discussed giving the Lions Hall permission to put up their own handicap signs during the lunches instead of installing permanent signs. The city clerk will contact the city attorney to see if this would be allowed.

The city clerk told the council with the new Iowa gas tax the City should receive around \$7,000.00 more in road use tax funds.

The City 2015-16 Budget was presented. The city clerk went through the budget with the council. R. Baker made a motion to accept the 2015-16 budget; seconded by J. Carroll. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor Pro Tem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously

There was discussion about the Warren Co. Board of Supervisors approving the seal coat for Inwood St. West of Martensdale to 30th and 30th to Hwy. 92. The City will send a letter to the Board of Supervisors stating Martensdale agrees with the seal coating.

J. Carroll made a motion to adjourn; seconded by S. Henson. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor Morrow declared the motion carried unanimously.
