Regular Session Minutes
October 5, 2015

Meeting called to order by Mayor Pro Tem, Nathan Wheeldon.

Members present: Scott Henson, Ryan Baker, and Doug Reynolds.

Members absent: Mayor Morrow and John Carroll.

John Carroll has turned in a letter of resignation for his city council seat due to moving out of the city limits.

The consent agenda and September 14, 2015 minutes were approved on a motion by D. Reynolds; seconded by R. Baker. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor Pro Tem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously.

The city clerk and city council went through the State of Iowa Auditor Report on the periodical review that was completed in December 2013. The State had several recommendations for the city to review and there are some of their recommendations that the city can comply with and others that will be a little harder for a city of our review done in January or February of 2016. The city clerk will send out bids for the review, otherwise the State will complete the review. The city council stated that would be fine.

Robert Seymour said the city pick-up needed repair work and he will probably take it to Cumming, IA.

Bob stated that McClure Engineering was coming to talk with him on Oct. 14th on the sewer project.

The city council decided to reset Beggar's Night to Oct. 30th from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The city clerk will post flyers.

There was discussion regarding the Iowa D.O.T. revising maps. Mayor Pro Tem Wheeldon has reviewed the information received from the D.O.T. and said there were no new streets and all current street names were correct. He will review it further to make sure everything is okay for the city information.

S. Henson made a motion to adjourn; seconded by D. Reynolds. Question was called for and on a voice vote Mayor Pro Tem Wheeldon declared the motion carried unanimously.
