

ORDINANCE NO. 10.02.2014

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARTENSDALE, IOWA, BY ADDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SANITARY SEWER SURCHAGES AND RENTAL RATES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Martensdale, Iowa:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Martensdale, Iowa, is amended by adding a provisions pertaining to sanitary sewer surcharges and rental rates in Chapter 99, Section 02 which is hereby adopted to read as follows:

99.02 SURCHARGE.

Each user of the municipal sanitary sewer system shall pay a \$6.00 per month storm sewer fee.

Each user of the municipal sanitary sewer system shall pay a sanitary sewer service charge for the use of and for the service supplied by the municipal sanitary sewer system based upon the amount and rate of water consumed as follows:

1. From and after the 1st of October, 2014, the first 2000 gallons used per month shall be \$36.00 per month (minimum monthly bill). All water usage over 2,000 gallons used per month shall be charged at a rate of \$5.60 per 1,000 gallons
2. From and after the 1st of July, 2015, the first 2000 gallons used per month shall be \$37.10 per month (minimum monthly bill). All water usage over 2,000 gallons used per month shall be charged at a rate of \$5.80 per 1,000 gallons.
3. From and after the 1st of July, 2016, the first 2000 gallons used per month shall be \$38.20 per month (minimum monthly bill). All water usage over 2,000 gallons used per month shall be charged at a rate of \$5.95 per 1,000 gallons
4. From and after the 1st of July, 2017, the first 2000 gallons used per month shall be \$39.35 per month (minimum monthly bill). All water usage over 2,000 gallons used per month shall be charged at a rate of \$6.15 per 1,000 gallons.

For all customers the minimum sanitary sewer service charge shall be the minimum amount listed above, which is necessary to retire the indebtedness, to pay operating, maintenance, and replacement and to fund reserves necessary for maintaining the sanitary sewer facility. Any industrial customer shall pay its proportional share of the costs to treat wastewater based on allocation of costs with respect to loading from BOD5, Suspended Solids, Ammonia and toxic pollutants. This chapter will take precedence over any terms and conditions of agreements or contracts between the City and any user, which are inconsistent with Section 204(b)(1)(A) of the Clean Water Act and Federal Regulations.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudicated invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 03.02.2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARTENSDALE, IOWA BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO WATER SERVICE RATES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Martensdale, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Chapter 92, Section 02 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Martensdale, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

92.02 Rates and Services. Water service shall be furnished at the following monthly rate within the City:


1. From and after the first day of April 2017, the first 2,000 gallons used per month shall be \$31.70 per month (minimum bill). All water usage over 2,000 gallons used per month shall be charged at a rate of \$5.15 per 1,000 gallons.

2. From and after the first day of July 2017, the first 2,000 gallons used per month shall be \$32.65 per month (minimum bill). All water usage over 2,000 gallons used per month shall be charged at a rate of \$5.30 per 1,000 gallons.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudicated invalid or unconstitutional.


SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
