### City of Martensdale Regular City Council Meeting Minutes

August 5, 2024

Mayor Brad Prichard called the meeting to order.

Members present: Scott Henson, Travis Berger, Matt Gideon, Deb Hutchison, and Peggy Halterman.

Members absent: None.

The agenda was approved by Henson seconded by Halterman. On a roll call vote: Henson, Aye; Berger, Aye; Gideon, Aye; Hutchison, Aye; and Halterman, Aye. Mayor Prichard declared the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Prichard thanked the FAA for putting up the flags for July 4 and thanked the city council members for being at the meeting.

No citizen comments. Kevin Conklin, 415 Rock Island, was present to discuss a water problem in his backyard and garage. The drain that goes down the alley is flowing in his yard and his garage was wet the last time it happened. The city will get a quote to place a line in his yard to resolve the problem.

Mayor Prichard thanked everyone for being at the meeting and thanked Mr. Conklin for attending.

The consent agenda was presented: the July 8, 2024, minutes, the August 2024 payables and receipts, the August 2024 payables, and the June 2024 financials. Hutchison made a motion to approve the consent agenda; seconded by Berger. On a roll call vote: Henson, Aye; Berger, Aye; Gideon, Aye; Hutchison, Aye; and Halterman, Aye. Mayor Prichard declared the motion carried unanimously.

City Clerk Report: The city clerk asked to transfer funds from the Road Use Tax fund to the general fund for the street resurfacing project (60,610.00). Mayor Prichard declared the motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Report: Zach Wood stated he would like to install the fire hydrant on Franklin Dr. and the one by City Hall on Center St. which was budgeted. There was discussion on installing the new furnace and air conditioner at city hall, Zach stated he is waiting on another bid.

Fire Report: Chief Henson stated there were 3 fire calls; 15 EMS calls; and 4 storm sighting calls.

Additional Expenses: None.

A 2-mile radius was presented for LRG Holdings (Ryan Gray), Part of the SE1/4 of Section 22, T 76N, R 25W, Warren County, Iowa. Mr. Gray is building a new home for himself at the parcel. Gideon made a motion to approve the 2-mile radius for LRG Holdings; seconded by Hutchison. On a roll call vote: Henson, Aye; Berger, Aye; Gideon, Aye; Hutchison, Aye; and Halterman, Aye. Mayor Prichard declared the motion carried unanimously.

A 2-mile radius was presented for Sandquist Investments, Part of Parcel P of the SE1/4 of the SW ¼ of Section 27 and the NE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 34, T 76N, R 25W, Warren County, Iowa. Henson made a motion to approve the 2-mile radius for Sandquist Investments; seconded by Halterman. On a roll call vote: Henson, Aye; Berger, Aye; Gideon, Aye; Hutchison, Aye; and Halterman, Aye. Mayor Prichard declared the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution 08.01.2024.3 A Resolution Fixing Date for a Meeting on the Authorization of a Loan and Disbursement Agreement and the Issuance of Not to Exceed \$600,000 General Obligation Capital Loan Notes of the City of Martensdale, State of Iowa, for the purpose of providing funds to pay costs of carrying out essential corporate purpose project(s) as hereinafter described was presented, Gideon made a motion to accept Resolution 08.01.2024.3; seconded by Berger. On a roll call vote: Henson, Aye; Berger, Aye; Gideon, Aye; Hutchison, Aye; and Halterman, Aye. Mayor Prichard declared the motion carried unanimously.

An engagement agreement with Ahlers Law Firm as the city's attorney for sewer lagoon lift station was presented. Henson made a motion to approve the engagement agreement with Ahlers Law Firm for the sewer lagoon lift station; seconded by Halterman. Resolution 08.01.2024.4 A Resolution Authorizing the Martensdale City Clerk to Act as City Treasurer for the City of Cumming, Iowa was presented. After reviewing the resolution, the mayor and city council did not want to approve it due to the statement that the Martensdale city clerk, Donna Bahun would the treasurer for the City of Cummings. The city clerk agreed. This will be tabled until the next meeting. The city clerk will contact the city attorney.

Open Forum: Mayor Prichard stated that a yard has been mowed that have had several complaints. The city clerk was asked to send out a letter regarding another yard that has not been mowed.

Fire Chief Scott Henson stated the fire fights will be August 24, Iowa Ave. will be closed between Center St. and School St. during this time.
