Maintenance Report: Zach Wood said he needed to gravel East St. cost around \$660.00. The city council told him to purchase the gravel. The cost to fix the hydrant would be around \$650.00. The council told him to repair it. He said the backhoe needs repairs. The city clerk will review the current budget for repairs to the backhoe.
