Clerk's Report: No report.

Maintenance Report: Zach Wood said he has talked to McClure Engineering about the new pumps for the sewer lagoon and they are waiting on pricing. He said he needs to purchase flow test and pressure tests for the hydrants, and 3 new batteries for the dump truck. The city council told him to purchase the materials. Zach said the water tower should be completed in another week.

Fire Report: Fire Chief Henson stated there were 16 EMS calls, and 3 fire calls.

A revised 2-mile radius was presented for Darr Land Development (future homestead) Parcel 'Y' a part of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section 17, Township 76 North, Range 25 West of the 5th P.M., Warren County, Iowa, described as follows: Beginning at the SW corner of Parcel "W" as shown by Plat of Survey filed as Instrument# 2017-05484; thence S 89"29'39" W, along the South line of said NE 1 / 4 NW 1 / 4, a distance of 220.03'; thence N 80"29'39" E a distance of 220.03'; thence S 00"22'13" W, along the West line of said Parcel "W", a distance of 566.20' to the point of beginning.
