The Norwalk EMS Contract for services to Martensdale was discussed. The city clerk presented costs adding this cost to the property taxes. The city council went through the contract and changed the pricing to negotiate with Norwalk. The city clerk will send the contract to the city attorney and contact the State Auditor about whether any funds from the township money to the fire dept. could be applied to pay for some of the cost.

Residents have been asking how many chickens are allowed in the City. The City will need to review the ordinance book but some council members did not think it was allowed at all.
